

## **General Information**

The Association of Manitoba Hydro Staff and Supervisory Employees (AMHSSE) offer nine separate scholarships for dependents of their members to promote post-secondary education for members and their families.

## **Scholarships**

## AMHSSE Leadership Award \$1500.00

Open to all dependents of AMHSSE members entering their first year of full-time studies (Certificate, Diploma, Degree) at an accredited post-secondary school, college, or university

#### AMHSSE Returning Undergraduate Award \$1500.00

Open to all dependents of AMHSSE members in continuing beyond their first year of studies in a full-time program (Diploma, Degree) at an accredited post-secondary school, college, or university

#### AMHSSE Humanitarian Award \$1500.00

Open to all dependents of AMHSSE members entering their first year of full-time studies at an accredited post-secondary school, college, or university.

#### AMHSSE Post-Secondary Trades Award (5 x \$300)

Open to all dependents of AMHSSE members entering Trade Apprenticeship Programs as described on the Manitoba Government Trades Website

### AMHSSE Need-Based Award \$1500.00

Open to all children of AMHSSE members entering their first year of full-time studies (Certificate, Diploma, Degree) or continuing beyond their first year and <u>being granted an accommodation</u> at an accredited post-secondary school, college, or university.

\*No age restrictions apply for the Need-Based Scholarship

## **Eligibility**

- The scholarships are open to all children 25yrs and younger of an AMHSSE member except for the Need-Based Scholarship which has no age restrictions
- A person is eligible for one award only but may apply for multiple awards.
- Children of the AMHSSE Executive are not eligible.



To be eligible, the child must be 25 yrs. or younger and are:

- the natural child of the AMHSSE member
- a child adopted "legally" or "in fact" by the AMHSSE member while under the age of 21
- A child in the legal guardianship of an AMHSSE member.
- A child of a spouse or common law of AMHSSE member (blended family)

## **Field of Study**

- Any full-time program in an accredited post-secondary school, college or university are eligible for the \$1500 awards.
- Any Manitoba Apprenticeship Program is eligible for the Post-Secondary Trades Award

### **Selection Committee**

An outside consultant may be hired to review and grade all applications.

Scores for the Leadership, Humanitarian, Undergraduate Awards will be based on grades, essays, and application form.

Scores for the Post-Secondary Trades Award will be based on essays and the application form.

Three members of the AMHSSE Executive will make up the Selection Committee and review the consultant's recommendations if applicable.

The Selection Committee will choose the winner(s) for each category based on a point scoring system and may interview the applicant if required. The Selection Committee will forward the applicants names for AMHSSE Board approval.

The AMHSSE Board reserves the right not to offer an award in a particular category.

# How to apply

## **Application Form**

Forms are available online on the AMHSSE website. Contact your AMHSSE representative for more information. Applicants can apply for more than one scholarship.

## **Submission Requirements**

All submissions must be accompanied by the following

- AMHSSE Scholarship application form
- Photocopy of transcript of marks for Grade 12 (Leadership or Humanitarian Awards)
- Photocopy of transcript of previous semester (Undergraduate Award)
- Essay as described under each award
- A separate essay must be supplied for each scholarship being applied for

#### AMHSSE Leadership Award \$1500.00

Provide a one to two-page essay describing your leadership skills, community / school involvement or volunteering. The essay will be judged on how you give back to the community / school.

#### AMHSSE Returning Undergraduate Award \$1500.00

Provide a one to two-page essay on career goals, community participation, extracurricular activities and any other involvement that sets you above the rest.

### AMHSSE Humanitarian Award \$1500.00

Provide a one to two-page essay describing how you contributed to the wellbeing of others less fortunate than yourself.

## AMHSSE Post-Secondary Trades Award (5 x \$300)

Provide a 200-word essay describing what trade you are enrolled in and why you should receive the award. Five separate awards for \$300 will be awarded to individuals.



### AMHSSE Need-Based Award \$1500.00

Provide a 200-word essay describing career goals and why you should receive the award.
